PASTOR'S RAMBLINGS

As I thought about something to write about in March Ramblings, I decided to look up Webster's definition of "March." What an eye opener! Webster defines it as "to move along steadily, usually with a rhythmic stride and in step with others, to move in a direct purposeful manner, to make steady progress."

That's how we are to be about it. Moving in a direct purposeful manner, in step with others, making steady progress. So what are we to be about?

Jesus said it clearly to His disciples (that's also us) after His resurrection in Matthew 28:19-20.

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen."

A very daunting task! The command here is "GO, make disciples, baptize them, and teach them to observe all that Jesus commanded! This isn't a command for a select few! Peter writes in 1 Peter 2:9 "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light..."

That you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness...
Jesus reinforced that just prior to His ascension in Acts 1:8.
"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem (Beaverton), and in all Judea (Michigan), and Samaria (United States), and to the end of the earth."

Implicit in all three of three of these commands is the understanding

that you have a very good knowledge of what Jesus commanded. It's very hard to teach what you don't know! A very daunting task indeed! Note in Acts 1:8 that Jesus not only sent a teacher to indwell us: "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you." (John 14:26) and as He said in Acts 1:8 "you will receive power!)
